Eco Corner (some terms)

Economic Sustainability (Profit) focuses on conserving the natural resources that provide physical inputs for economic production, including both renewable and exhaustible inputs.

Environmental Sustainability (Planet) adds greater emphasis on the life support systems, such as the atmosphere or soil, that must be maintained for economic production or human life to even occur.

Social Sustainability (People) focuses on the human effects of economic systems, and the category includes attempts to eradicate poverty and hunger, as well as to combat inequality.
